OB1 All Weather Repair Tape Extreme Strength is a crystal clear structure repair tape intended for repair, assembly covering and protecting of clear/transparent objects such as glass, plastic or film.

Application:

Used for for sealing of broken or punctured surfaces where transparency and resistance to elements are imperative. Suitable for repair of glass surfaces (windows, furniture, headlights, taillights, windshields), as well as for plastic greenhouse covers. Not suitable for PE and PTFE.

Usage Guidelines:

Upon application, the treated surface must be clean and free from dust and grease. Avoid touching the exposed adhesive surface in order to keep full adhesive performance. Firm hand pressure is recommended for 30 seconds, ensuring to press out any air bubbles for optimal bonding. Can be used after 2hrs, maximum strength after 24hrs. **Not for use as an electrical tape.**
